

GIFT OF S\$125M FROM THE FAMILY OF THE LATE MR NG TENG FONG – FOUNDING CHAIRMAN OF THE FAR EAST ORGANIZATION AND SINO GROUP

JurongHealth receives a very significant gift of S\$125 million from the family of the late Mr Ng Teng Fong – founding chairman of the Far East Organization and its Hong Kong-based sister company Sino Group. The donation will significantly boost JurongHealth's vision of transforming care with its future integrated healthcare hub in the West.

In honour and recognition of the late Mr Ng and his family's tremendous gift which will benefit needy patients and the community for many years to come, the future Jurong General Hospital will be renamed as the Ng Teng Fong Hospital.

Announced by Health Minister Khaw Boon Wan at the Budget Debate 2011, the news of the donation was met with sincere gratitude by the Management and staff of JurongHealth.

Said Chief Executive Officer Mr Foo Hee Jug said: "We are deeply grateful to the family of the late Mr Ng Teng Fong – an eminent philanthropist and a respected pioneer of Singapore who played a pivotal role in the remarkable transformation of Singapore. The donation will be used to set up the JurongHealth Fund in support of needy patients, continued education for our staff, facility enhancements, research, and to advance our mission of providing a hassle-free and integrated healthcare for our population."

The first integrated healthcare hub from ground up, the Ng Teng Fong Hospital and Jurong Community Hospital are slated to be ready in 2014 and early 2015 respectively. Centrally located at Jurong East Street 21, the twinned-hospitals will pave the way for seamless integrated care for the population in the West with 120 Consultation Rooms in the Specialist Outpatient Clinics, 18 Operating Theatres and a comprehensive suite of specialist services.
